Psa elevated with pt. With known prostate cancer; unsure why this lab was performed by our office instead of urology; advise he follow up promptly with Dr. Boren/urologist. Last notes reviewed.

Thyroid slightly underactive; would not advise starting any thyroid medication presently but advise repeat diabetic and thyroid labs in 12 weeks. Please schedule office visit.

Urine protein a little more than is expected. Continue to drink plenty of water daily. Will monitor.

Wbc elevated as was in past. Advise pt. See oncology and urology; may be due to prostate cancer. Pt.had appt. To see them in June but traumatic injury of finger took precedence.

Hga1c, liver, renal, cholesterol, uric acid all stable.
